Missionary Larry Secrest: Larry and Bonnie Secrest are missionaries in Lima, Peru. They served in Lima in the 1970s as church planters (praise God the church continues today) and they were able to disciple people of all ages during this time. The Secrests have returned to Lima where Larry presently is one of the pastors of Iglesia Bíblica Gracia Eterna located in Barranco, Lima. It is already seen as the focal point for pastors throughout Peru because of the extended ministry of Heart Cry Mission.

Missionary/Pastor Jim Adams: James E. Adams with his wife, Nancy, did missionary work in Colombia, where he helped train pastors and started a church that continues to thrive there. Together they have served Christ for 50 years. Jim has authored four books, two in English and two in Spanish. He has pastored Cornerstone Church in Mesa, Arizona since 1980 and teaches theology and preaches at conferences in Spanish and English all over the world.

Missionary Noble Vater: Noble and his wife Estela live in San Juan where Noble continues to pastor the Berean Baptist Church since 1963. He has had extensive outreach all throughout Latin America, preaching in the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica, the West Indies and throughout both Central and South America. In 1972 he established a book distributor that provides Spanish speaking literature to this day. He also was editor of 'Herald of Grace' for 8 ½ years.
